

Invitation for tenders (IFT)

Procurement of WHO Pesticide Evaluation Scheme (WHOPES) Recommended Long Lasting Insecticidal Mosquito Nets (LLINs) MOH/2018/ICT/B.2.5/08

1. The Ministry of Health, Ghana hereinafter referred to as the Purchaser, intends using part of its budgetary allocation to fund the procurement of WHO Pesticide Evaluation Scheme (WHOPES) Recommended Long Lasting Insecticidal Mosquito Nets (LLINs) to support the fight against Malaria.
2. The Purchaser now invites sealed tenders from eligible manufacturers or their authorized representatives for the supply of Long Lasting Insecticidal Mosquito Nets (LLINs) as detailed in Table 1 below;

3. Tendering will be conducted through the International Competitive Tendering (ICT) procedures specified in the Republic of Ghana's Procurement Act, 2003, Act 663 and Act 914 as Amended and is open to all Tenderers from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines of the Public Procurement Authority of the Republic of Ghana.
4. As part of the eligibility criteria for this Tender, all Tenderers are required to register with the Ghana Public Procurement Authority (PPA) (visit www.ppaghana.com for more information). Tenderers are also required to submit evidence of registration with their Tender submission. This is a mandatory requirement for all Tenderers. Tenderers who do not submit evidence of registration with the PPA will be rejected.
5. Tenderers must quote for the required product quantity. Tenders that do not offer the complete quantities will be rejected as incomplete. Delivery shall be within Ninety (90) days after contract signing. **THE PRODUCTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE GHANA FOOD AND DRUGS AUTHORITY AT THE TIME OF TENDERING**

6. A complete set of Tender Documents in ENGLISH may be purchased by interested Tenderers on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Two Hundred US Dollars (USD \$200.00)** or equivalent in Ghana Cedis. The method of payment will be cash. Interested eligible tenderers may obtain further information from the Procurement Unit, Room 5 and inspect the tender documents at the address given below;
6. The Tender Documents will be sent by courier to interested Tenderers upon an additional payment of **One Hundred US Dollars (US\$100.00)**. The documents will be promptly dispatched by courier upon receipt of evidence of payment but no liability can be accepted for loss or late delivery.
8. Sealed tenders must be delivered to the address below on or before 10.00am (local time) on **Wednesday 5th December, 2018**. All tenders must be accompanied by a Tender Security of 2% of the tender price. Tender Security must be in the Form of a **Bank Guarantee or Insurance Bond**. Tenders submitted without Tender Securities would be rejected as non-responsive.
9. Late tenders will be rejected. Electronic Tenders will not be permitted. Tenders will be opened in the presence of the tenderers' representatives, who choose to attend at the address below at 10.00am (local time) on **Wednesday 5th December, 2018**.
